Scrutinies

It has not been a practice of St. Ann's in recent history to celebrate the scrutinies for RCIA, however, they are being celebrated this year! For those who are unfamiliar, the scrutinies are "rites for self searching and repentance and have above all a spiritual purpose. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good." (RCIA 141) They encourage the ones who are to be baptized (the elect) to desire purification and redemption in Christ and prepare them to receive the Easter Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist! Please pray for our RCIA catechumens as they celebrate the scrutinies in the next couple of weeks and come ever closer to unity with us at the altar of our Lord. Please also continue to keep the candidates in your prayers who, having already been baptized, do not participate in the scrutinies but are nonetheless being purified and prepared to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church! Their journey is an inspiration and a reminder to us of God's work and abundant love toward all His children!



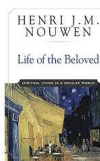
