From the Pastor's Desk:

Holy Week has begun! Palm Sunday is here!

With the busy-ness of this time of year, it is easy for Holy Week to be "just another week". I want to recommend some simple ways to make Holy Week more meaningful. I am NOT recommending you do all of these things. Rather, as you read the list, ask yourself if anything sticks out as a good fit for you and your family.

Ways to make Holy Week more meaningful:

1. **THINK PRAYER.** If you have to work or go to school during Holy Week, think about how you can incorporate prayer breaks into each day.
2. **MAKE AN ADDITIONAL SACRIFICE** by fasting and abstaining from meat on Holy Thursday and Holy Saturday in addition to Good Friday.
3. **DON'T WATCH TELEVISION** from sundown on Holy Thursday until Easter morning.
4. **GO to confession.** Confession will be offered an hour before all the Holy Week services.
5. **SET ASIDE** 10 minutes every day to read Passion accounts in the Gospels.
6. Make it a point to **FORGIVE** someone on Good Friday.
7. **PRAY** the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.
8. **OFFER UP** any pain or difficulties you experience during Holy Week and unite your sufferings with the pain of Christ.
9. **PRAY** the Stations of the Cross.
10. **ATTEND** all of the Triduum liturgies. The schedule is in this bulletin.

All of these are ways to enter more into the death of Jesus. As we enter more into His death, we experience more deeply the joy of the Lord's Resurrection.
