Snow Day Update and Plans Regarding Possible Future Inclement Weather Closures and Delays As you know, St. Pius has had 4 snow days this year. At this time, we are not required to make up any days. In preparation for any possible future inclement weather, we will make these missed days asynchronous learning days. This means that the classroom/homeroom teacher will provide students with assignments presented as either hard copy, posted in Google classroom, or a combination of both. All directions for grades PK3 - 5 were provided on Google Classroom on or about Friday, January 31, 2025. Middle School will be updated in real time. *Please note that asynchronous learning is different from virtual learning in that there are no virtual meetings and students work at his/her own pace. The school understands that weather closures and delays can be frustrating to many of our working families. St. Pius X Regional School follows Prince George's County decisions regarding weather closures. There are several reasons behind this approach. The public school district has tools and resources to assess road conditions and the overall safety of travel.
