The amounts shown as "Central Fund" represent receivables from a trust that has been established by the Diocese to manage and administer certain pooled funds of the Diocesan parishes. The trust is a separate legal entity from the Diocese. Current Central Fund rates for deposit categories used by the parish are as follows:

During 2019 the parish employed an engineering firm to estimate the cost of required major maintenance and capital improvements over the next ten years. The estimated amounts, not adjusted for inflation, are: OLF - \$411,000 and IC - \$154,000. Central Fund amounts in both Deposit Categories not otherwise earmarked, are available to fund future major maintenance and capital improvements as well as any operating shortfalls that may occur.

The parish occasionally sends cash to the Diocese for the purpose of increasing the balance in the Central Fund. The parish can request payments from the "Demand" portion of the Central Fund at any time. Large, one-time expenditures by the parish requiring a withdrawal from any portion of the Central Fund are subject to the approval of the Diocese.

In August 2018 the parish received a charitable bequest in the principal amount of \$95,711. The income from this bequest may be used for general parish purposes, but the principal must remain invested and unencumbered. The principal and a portion of accumulated interest are invested in the Central Fund Program of the Diocese in the deposit category maturing two years from deposit date. A parishioner contributed \$8,000 specifically for the OLF stone wall rebuild and the monies are earmarked for that purpose only. The monies will be used as the wall is built.
