




## Join us for a Special Reception with Fr. Gabriel!

This is a wonderful opportunity to meet him and spend some quality time getting to know him better. We have prepared a delightful spread of coffee, orange juice, and


cookies for everyone to enjoy, this Saturday and Sunday after every mass.
