Isidore was born in the 12th century into a poor and humble family in Spain. From his boyhood, he labored at the DeVargas Estate as a farmhand. Isidore prayed to the Good God, to the saints and his guardian angel daily as he worked in the fields. It was his custom to arise before dawn and attend daily Mass and adore God in the Most Blessed Sacrament in Madrid. Isidore often came late to work but the owner had great respect for him because the holy angels helped him plow the fields. His vocation was to the married life and his wife was Maria Torribia, a pious maid servant. After their infant son died, they dedicated their lives

to the service of God and neighbor. This pious couple was very poor, yet they gave of what they had to those who were even poorer.

Creator God, watch over the members of this community as we strive to appreciate the wonders of the natural world that you have given us. St. Isidore drew others to value nature; may we never cease to be impressed by the glories of your creation. We pray this in the name of Jesus Christ the Lord.
