One: They do not fear the drought for they will bear fruit.


Many: Like trees, may our spiritual roots grow near the stream

Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen.


INVITATION TO GIVE/RECEIVING OUR GIFTS
