FOCUSING ON TODAY'S GOSPEL John 14,23-29 If anyone loves me, he will keep my word and my Father

will love him; and we will come to him and make a room in his home.

oday, before the celebration of the Ascension and Pentecost, we read once more the words of the so called sermon of the Last Supper, where we should see the different ways to present a unique message, insofar as it all emanates from the blessed union of Christ with the Father and from God's will to associate us closely to this mystery of love.



One day, St. Therese of the Child Jesus

was offered several gifts for her to choose one but quite decidedly, despite her youth, she said «I choose everything!». When she grew older she realized that choosing everything actually meant desiring to be love and devotion in the Church, for a body without love would be totally meaningless. The mystery of God's love, is a concrete, personal love incarnated within the Son Jesus, who gives us everything: Himself, his life and his deeds are the best and clearest of God's message to us.

From this love encompassing everything is where "peace" is born from. A word that, today, we all dream about: we want "peace" but alarm and violence surround us. Peace will only be achieved if we turn towards Jesus, as He gives us his peace as a fruit of his total love. Though He does not give it as the world does (cf. Jn 14:27), as the peace bestowed by Jesus is not made of calm unconcern, but just the opposite: of a solidarity that becomes brotherhood; of a capacity to take a look at ourselves and at others with new eyes, as the Lord does, and thus, forgives us. A great serenity overflows us and helps us to see things just as they actually are, not as they look like. And by following this way we shall reach happiness.

«The Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of all that I have told you» (Jn 14:26). In these last days of Easter let us beg to open up to the Holy Spirit; we received it when we were baptized and confirmed, but now we must —as a last gift— make the Spirit to spring up from within us to take us where we would not have dared by ourselves.

SACRAMENT PREP POLICY

In compliance with Archdiocesan policy and recommendations for the preparation and reception of the Sacraments, St. Patrick requires that any candidate receiving the Sacraments of Confirmation, First Reconciliation and First Eucharist must be actively involved in age appropriate Religious Education for a minimum of 1 year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacraments. The candidates must have regular attendance in our programs. Additionally, it will be expected that each candidate will continue to be involved in age appropriate classes and regularly attend weekend Mass during the period of Preparation for the Sacrament.

SACRAMENTS

Adult Baptism:

Adults seeking baptism are expected to participate in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). RCIA begins in the fall with the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation in the Spring (Easter). For information call the Office 503-266-9411

Infant Baptisms:

Registered parishioners are expected to complete a Baptismal Preparation program prior to scheduling a baptism. Baptismal preparation programs are offered 4 times a year.

Marriage Policy:

Please contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding to ensure adequate time for these preparations.



MARION VICARIATE CHANGES REGARDING RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The clergy of the Marion vicariate has come to an agreement regarding Vicariate Policies in the conduct of preparing and guiding children, youth, and adults for Sacraments and for Faith formation. These policies take effect this May 2022. The Marion Vicariate includes Sacred Heart - St. Louis (Gervais), St. James (Molalla), St. Mary (Mt. Angel, Holy Rosary Mission - Scotts Mills), St. Paul (Silverton), St. Paul (St. Paul), St. Luke (Woodburn, St. Agnes Mission -Hubbard), and St. Patrick (Canby). The vicariate would like to see families select and become established in a "home" parish, meaning the parish you primarily attend. The home parish is fundamental in the parishioner's life. Therefore, families that desire sacraments, want to enter faith formation, or request a Quinceañera, are required to be registered with their home parish. If you desire to receive the sacraments or Quinceañera outside your home parish, you will be required to present a letter of permission from the pastor of your home parish. St. Patrick parish registration forms can be found in the parish office. Other vicariate-wide changes include one form to certify that a godparent or sponsor is a "Catholic in Good Standing." This form will need to be signed by the godparent or sponsor's home parish pastor. The Sponsor Form can be found in the parish office or by visiting our website at stpatcanby.org. Finally, a notable change, will be the deadline or cut-off date to register for our religious education programs. The vicariate has decided that registrations must be received prior to Labor Day weekend which is September 5th this year. If you have not registered for our programs prior to that date, you will need to wait until the next program year. These policies and changes have been made in the spirit of providing the greater community with a consistent pastoral approach. The guidelines are made to encourage continued faith formation, evangelization, and catechesis with every step of your faith journey.




VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL


