Diocesan & Parish Protocols for Returning to Public Masses

- The dispensation from the obligation to participate in Sunday Mass is still in force and will not change until it is deemed safe.
- If you are not feeling well, you should not attend Mass.
- The vulnerable and elderly are discouraged from attending Mass on Sundays until further notice; however, our daily Masses, will take place in the main Church, and will be available with less people for those in this category.
- Children under age seven are discouraged from attending Mass until further notice due to new complications from the illness identified among children.
- All bathrooms, cry rooms, nurseries, and water fountains will be
- Parishioners must enter through the south doors and exit through the west (front) doors.
- There should be no visiting in the church, in the doorways, or the parking lot. Social distance guidelines must be maintained.
- Hand-shaking, hugging, and hand-holding should be avoided before, during, and after Mass.
- Parishioners in attendance should provide their own face masks and wear them during Mass, except at the moment of receiving Com-
- · Parishioners will be seated by Ushers in order to allow for seating and appropriate social distancing on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Seating will be limited to 50% of seating capacity. Pews and sections of pews for seating are marked by in-seat signs for 1-3 persons, 1-2 persons, or larger families/households.
- If the church is at capacity, overflow seating is available in the parish hall where Mass will be live-streamed and Holy Communion will be served at the proper time.
- Worship aids/song sheets will be provided in the place of hymnals to maintain a safe environment. They must be taken home or thrown away after each use.
- Those who leave the church before the end of Mass won't be allowed to re-enter the church.
- Offertory envelopes can be placed in the baskets at the entrance and exit of the church.
- Communion will be distributed only one side/section at a time.
- Those receiving Communion cannot wear gloves to receive the Eucharist. The person receiving Communion must keep their hands flat as best as possible. They should not try to grab or try to take the
- After the presiding priest received the Body and Blood of Christ, he will hold the consecrated host above the altar and declare the traditional Act of Faith, "The Body of Christ" and all the people who will receive Holy Communion will declare their faith in the Real Presence by responding as usual, "Amen." This will eliminate the usual individual dialogue between the priest/deacon and recipient and thus make the sacramental moment safer.




