Weekend Masses - May 8 & 9, 2021

Regulations announced Tuesday evening has limited us to 15 people inside for mass, therefore we have come up with a solution that will hopefully help more Parishioners have access to the Sacraments. If this goes well this weekend, we will continue in this way until regulations are lifted and we can have everyone inside again.

Please follow these steps to join us at mass over the weekend.

- * Mass times remain the same as our regular schedule:
 - * Okotoks(5pm Saturday, 8am 10am 5pm Sunday)
 - * Black Diamond (5pm Saturday, 9am Sunday)
- * When you arrive at the church, we ask that you park your vehicle (East side of the church ~ Okotoks); (West side of the church ~ Black Dia~ mond), facing the church.
- * Keep an empty space in between each vehicle. Ushers will be outside to help direct traffic. This space is required to follow regulations and allow for ministers to distribute Communion.
- * Tune your radio to **107.9FM** to listen to mass
- * During the preparation of the gifts, Ushers will walk around the lot with baskets for your offering.
- * When it is time for Communion, Ministers will walk to each vehicle to distribute Communion. Please remain in your vehicle.

As per the Alberta Government regulations, masks are to be worn at all times while in the church, for those who are able.







