Hospitality Minister

The Minister of Hospitality welcomes all to our liturgical gatherings with a smile Responsibilities include

- Greeting people as they arrive
- Assisting with seating
- Taking up the collection
- Organizing the presentation of the gifts
- Passing out the bulletins
- Tidying the pews after Mass
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to Mass
- Usually scheduled every four to six weeks

Lectors

The Lector proclaims God's word at Mass. This includes the first and second readings, the Psalm and the Prayers of the Faithful.

- Lectors are scheduled to serve every four to six weeks.
- All who are confirmed are welcome.

Music Ministry

Music Ministers include musicians who play, principally the organ, piano, or guitar, as well as other instruments; the choir and cantors; and the musicians and singers in the contemporary music group. In so many ways prayerful liturgies are only as good as the music (and music ministers) that supports them. We are always looking for more people with both desire and some talent to serve as music ministers. The time commitment varies depending on one's particular interest.

Art and Environment

This team works behind the scenes to transform our worship space for the liturgical seasons. Responsibilities include

- decorating the church before the holidays
- watering plants.

Eucharistic Ministers

Ministers are appointed by the pastor to assist in administering the Sacrament of Holy Communion. They may also take the sacraments to those who are ill or otherwise unable to attend Mass. Eucharistic Ministers are needed at our weekend and daily Masses.
