#### **MISSION STATEMENT**

As a part of the Local Church of Northcentral Indiana, we the people of St. Francis of Assisi Parish are called to fulfill our mission as a University Parish and Newman Center. We serve as the Catholic Community of Ball State University by: reaching out to Ball State University students, faculty and professional staff; providing a nurturing environment in which all are welcome; and encouraging and challenging each other to grow in faith and knowledge.



#### **History of Christ the King**

Pope Pius XI universally instituted the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King in 1925 in his encyclical Quas Primas. At the time, secularism was on the rise, and many Christians, even Catholics, were doubting Christ's authority, as well as the Church's, and even doubting Christ's existence. Pius XI, and the rest



of the Christian world, witnessed the rise of dictatorships in Europe, and saw Catholics being taken in by these earthly leaders.

Just as the Feast of Corpus Christi was instituted when devotion to the Eucharist was at a low point, the Feast of Christ the King was instituted during a time when respect for Christ and the Church was waning, when the feast was most needed. In fact, it is still needed today, evidenced by its institution in many other Christian communities.

Pius hoped the institution of the feast would have various effects. They were:

That nations would see that the Church has the right to freedom, and immunity from the state (Quas Primas, 32). That leaders and nations would see that they are bound to give respect to Christ (Quas Primas, 31).

That the faithful would gain strength and courage from the celebration of the feast, as we are reminded that Christ must reign in our hearts, minds, wills, and bodies (Quas Primas, 33).

Initially the feast was celebrated on "reformation Sunday" when protestants would commemorate their leaving the Catholic Church (last weekend of October), but in the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council the feast was moved to the end of the Liturgical Year and is now celebrated one week prior to the first Sunday of Advent (Catholic New Year's) — a purposeful time of preparing, waiting, and making straight the path for Jesus in our lives — the feast that proclaims Christ being Creator, Redeemer, Preserver, and Ruler of the universe is just as relevant today as ever.


