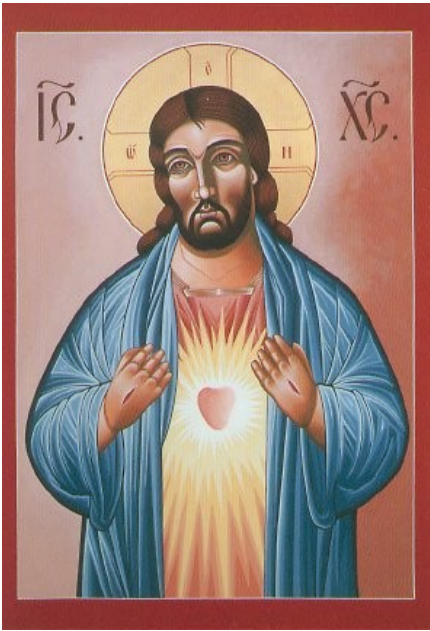

Please note that SHARE, RCIA, Adoration, and Friday Rosary are all cancelled November 24, 25 & 26, due to the Thanksgiving holiday.

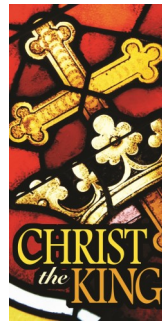


Thanksgiving Day Mass is at 10 am in the church. The collection is for the Community Action Center Food Bank.
