

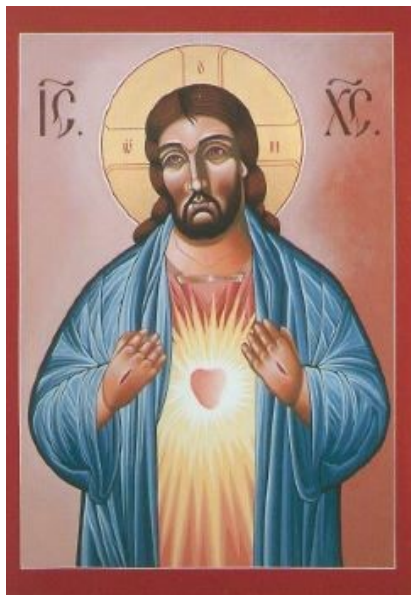

Come decorate our tree in the social hall through December 10 with any of the following for children and teens:

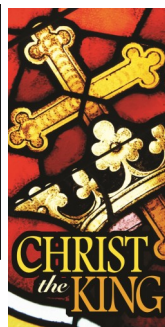

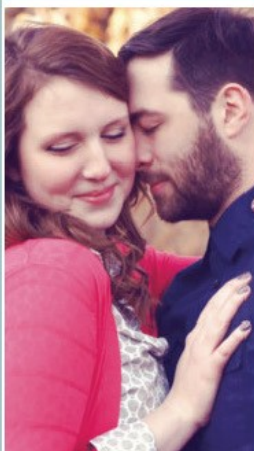
