Forming a Building Committee

Thanks to the many prayers and valuable feedback of the parish family, the St. Ann's Pastoral and Finance Councils have approved the establishment of a Building Committee to begin a comprehensive design phase for our parish campus, with particular attention to the possible renovation/expansion/new construction of our parish hall. Of course, our Councils and the entire parish will be kept up-to-date and included in the process.

We deeply appreciate the good work of our Building Assessment Committee who advised our Councils: Roman Asbill, Glenn Backus, Cortni Hudspeth, Mike Knox, Cruz Luna Jr., Pati Martinez, Joshua Raef, Mark Reinart and Dcn. Gabe Rivas. Special thanks to Deacon Dave Rausch whose polling expertise helped us during the survey process.

More Survey Data

- The analysis software of the survey gave a mean score to the following items, with the most important score being 9 and the least important being 1:
- A designated bigger space for Youth Ministry: 6.51
- Additional classroom/meeting spaces: 6.46
- Larger parish hall for large events: 5.44
- Larger and better organized kitchen: 5.43
- Two separate halls one for more formal events and one for more informal events e.g., play athletic: 4.81
- Outside aesthetic improvements e.g., prayer grotto, cook area, gathering spaces, parking areas: 4.73
- Connected to the church under one roof via covered walkway, corridor or other design: 4.48
- More fellowship areas e.g., coffee and refreshment area, bookstore/gift shop area, lounge area, information center: 3.83
- Community outreach space e.g., food pantry, thrift store, etc.: 3.71
- Over 90% of the respondents expressed that improvements to our parish center are either somewhat, very or extremely important that they would be able/willing to donate to a construction/capital improvement fund in the next five years beyond their normal tithing.

CATHOLIC NOVEMBER — Remembering Saints & Souls

This year, the Solemnity of All Saints falls on a Sunday. Besides taking care of two holy days in one, we have the opportunity to celebrate some cultural and Catholic customs that weekend and during the entirety of November:

- St. Ann's Trunk-or-Treat Saturday, October 31, 6-8 p.m. -- see reverse flyer
- Candles and Reading of Names -- Weekend Masses, October 31-November 1. Before each Mass, we will read the names of those whose funerals have taken place at St. Ann's since last November 1 and light a candle in memory of each person.
- Table of Remembrance Weekend Masses, October 31-November 1. Please bring pictures of loved ones who have died to place on the Table of Remembrance near the baptism font in the front. These can be retrieved the following weekend.
- All Saints Procession Weekend Masses, October 31-November 1. Children and youth are invited to come to Masses dressed as one of the saints of the Church. They will process in the opening procession and be invited to share something about their saint during the homily time. Special participation gifts will be given to those who participate.
- Blessing of Holy Water Weekend Masses, October 31-November 1. Since blessed water calls us to reconnect with the promise of eternal life in our baptism, all are invited to bring containers of water with them to Masses that weekend to be blessed. This will be especially helpful since COVID is as-yet preventing us from having holy water available in the narthex.
- **Visit and Blessing at Cemeteries** Sunday, November 1, at 2 p.m. Our parish deacons will be present at both Dreamland Cemetery (in front of the little wooden chapel) and Memory Gardens (in front of the Holy Family statue on the west side) to pray the prayers for visiting the graves of loved ones taken from the Church's Book of Blessings. Holy water will also be blessed at the cemeteries for visits to the graves of loved ones.
- All Souls Envelopes The entire month of November. All Masses in November
 will be offered for the names of the deceased written on the special All Souls envelopes (extras are located in the narthex as well as attached to this weekend's bulle-
