Throughout this challenging year, the Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA) has provided more than \$1 million back into our parishes for their most urgent and pressing needs. The Divine Mercy Chaplet

1. Sign of the Cross
2. You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. Repeat 3x: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!
3. Our Father. 4. Hail Mary. 5. The Apostles' Creed
6. The Eternal Father (on each large bead): Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
7. On the 10 Small Beads: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
8. Repeat for the remaining decades
9. Conclusion (Repeat 3x): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
10. Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
