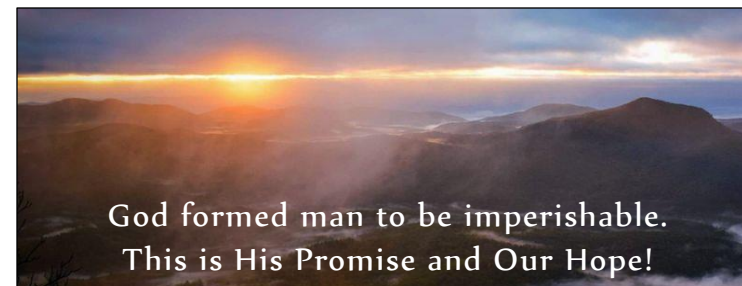

### Current Safety Guidelines for Hardin Catholic Churches

Each family will determine their own family members' level of risk and decide their own mask and distancing requirements. *There is one side of the sanctuary with pews roped off and one side open.*

We will continue the practice of hand sanitizing upon entering our buildings.

No one is required to share private health information, including vaccine status. **No judgments** will be made on how anyone is responding to the virus or reacting to the mandates or the lifting thereof!

*As always, those who have a serious reason are still exempt from attending Mass. This includes those who are ill, have significant health risk factors or care for someone who is immuno-compromised or ill, as well as those who have significant fear or anxiety of contracting the virus in a large group of persons*
