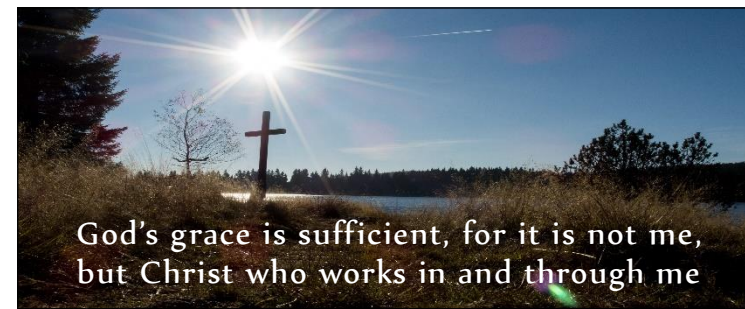

Vespers is the daily evening prayer of the Church - a 20 minute liturgy that includes chanting the psalms and a brief reading. It is one of the designated times of prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours (also known as the Divine Office). It is a way for the Church to follow the command to "Pray Always and Unceasingly." Many feel as if they are joining in a stream of prayer sent heavenward since the Liturgy of the Hours is prayed by so many - and has been prayed by many through the centuries! You are invited to try this way of prayer as a way to give thanks as a family for the week past and to prepare for the week ahead.
