We're thrilled to announce that the [INW Dyslexia Alliance](#), a local nonprofit dedicated to supporting individuals with dyslexia, their families, and professionals, is now offering services to our school community. We are partnering with the Inland Northwest Dyslexia Alliance to provide intervention services for students needing literacy support. This is an excellent opportunity for our families to utilize during the school day.

As stated on their website, "the INW Dyslexia Alliance is a nonprofit founded in 2022 with a mission to support, empower, and advocate for individuals with dyslexia, their families, and professionals in the Inland Northwest. In addition to offering dyslexia evaluations and literacy intervention through a "donate what you can" model, we provide various resources on our website and opportunities for connection through our Champions for Dyslexia initiative."

We are welcoming Maty Eide to our school as an intervention teacher from the Dyslexia Alliance starting June 16th. She will be available to work with your child one-on-one at St. Thomas More throughout the summer and continue the sessions during the school year.

The Alliance provides:

- Dyslexia evaluations
- One-on-one literacy intervention sessions (30 minutes, twice weekly)
- A flexible, pledge-based donation system to help make services accessible to all families
- This is **not** covered in our school tuition; financial support is provided directly by the Alliance.

Starting this summer, intervention services will be offered on-site at St. Thomas More!
