What is being proposed?

- Governor Jim Pillen placed \$7 million for school choice scholarships in his proposed budget to the Nebraska Legislature.
- These scholarships are intended to provide "gap assistance" funding for the 2026-27 school year for students who received school choice scholarships the last couple years. Check out [this impact report](#) to learn more about the students these scholarships helped.
- Next Wednesday (Feb. 18), the Appropriations Committee of the Nebraska Legislature will have a public hearing on these scholarships, as part of their process for determining whether to adopt school choice scholarships into the Legislature's budget proposal.
