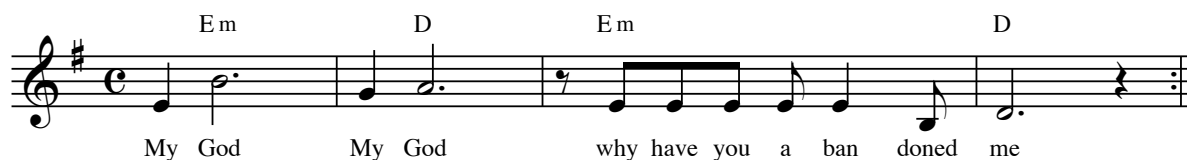


Psalm 22 - My God, My God - Ps 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24
