First Fridays - Come to the museum any first Friday of the month from 4-7 p.m. for free admission, refreshments, and art project.

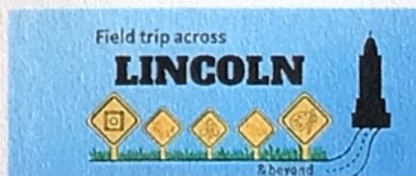
