What is the Vocations Office?

- The Vocations Office coordinates efforts of promotion, accompaniment, and formation of diocesan priests and those discerning a call to consecrated life.

What is a Vocation?

- Vocation is how God calls a person to serve Him in the world. God calls each of us through Baptism and Confirmation to serve Him in a specific way of life. You can follow God's call as a single person, married person, ordained priest or a vowed religious.

Why should we pray for Vocations?

- We pray to ask God to help more people hear His call and respond with courage to discern the priesthood or consecrated religious life.
- We also pray for all current priests for strength and fortitude as they follow Hebrews 7:26 to live as Jesus did: *It was fitting that we should have such a high priest: holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners, higher than the heavens.*
