

FR. LARA'S LINES

"Come to me, all you who are burdened, and I will give you rest" Matthew 11:28.

The meaning of the gospels is inexhaustible, especially when Jesus speaks. Each verse gives us a great deal to reflect on. The meaning can be applied to our daily lives for Jesus meets us where we are in our own space and time. Thinking about this Sunday's gospel verse, Matthew 11:28, can give us the comfort we need in times of distress. Jesus makes an invitation to those who are burdened: He promises rest.

Jesus makes an invitation

Like a good host, Jesus extends an invitation to us. He is always reaching out to us, even when we seem to be hard of hearing. He is inviting us to come into his presence. Every time you pray, Jesus invites you to contemplate his presence. Every time you come to Church, you are invited to be in Jesus' presence and, even more, when you receive communion you are invited to participate in his glorious life. Jesus gives us the freedom to accept or reject the invitation. Do you accept the invitation to be in Jesus' presence?

The invitation is to those who are burdened

The invitation is for the whole world. I think about this time of suffering and uncertainty because of the pandemic. I haven't met anyone who is not burdened; lockdown fatigue was very real. A lot of people are still on edge, looking for a way to find some normalcy and peace in their lives. I think about all the people who suffer addictions, who are sick, who are depressed, who have economic hardships, who have lost loved ones; we all carry heavy burdens. Jesus' invitation is for all of us. What burdens do you carry? Are you aware that Jesus is trying to help?

He promises rest

The invitation comes with an extraordinary reward. If we answer his call, Jesus will give us something that the world can never give. Resting in the presence of Jesus gives peace to our hearts: "Our hearts are restless until they rest in him." There is no other place where we can find eternal happiness and peace but in the presence of God. No matter how hard we try we will not find fulfillment in the world. Jesus is offering rest, which is peace, happiness, and fulfillment. Have you experienced the rest Jesus is promising? Answer Jesus' invitation and he will give you rest.

Independence Day is the summer holiday. Whether or not you think it came too soon, we need to make the most out of it. I know this year might look a little different with social-distance gatherings and no fireworks displays. Enjoy the 4th of July weekend.
