

Message from Fr. Steve

Dear Friends.

After discussion with the Pastoral Council and after receiving their recommendation I have decided to temporarily discontinue in person Masses and events at Sacred Heart Parish.

For many of you this is no change at all since you have been carefully staying at home to protect your health and the health of others. For about 150 people who have been attending our outdoor services during the summer, this is a dramatic change. We have managed to celebrate the Eucharist with the birds in our outdoor settings with dignity. Not receiving the Eucharist again even for a short period of time is truly a loss.

Hopefully this temporary suspension of services will be short. Over the last month the positivity rate of the coronavirus tests has gone way up in Pullman. The positivity rate for tests on campus is 16-20% and at the hospital 22% are positive. The greater prevalence of the virus in our community has increased the risk of transmission even when we follow all the safety protocols that have been so faithfully observed by our community members. It is critical that steps be taken to rein in the virus so as to protect the more vulnerable members of our town.

We will still take pictures for our parish directory. If you have not had your picture taken yet please sign up. It only takes a few minutes and I would love to see you.

Thank you for your understanding and patience. The staff here at Sacred Heart will continue to find new ways of reaching out to meet the needs of our community. If you are in need please let us know.


