

Open Arms for Refugees

Community Teams: The Heart of Community

Open Arms has used the model of a dedicated local Community Team that engages regularly with the family from Day One. This team is supported by specialized Open Arms co-chairs in housing, furnishings, ESL, employment, healthcare, and personal budgeting/finance. For example, in Cold Spring the Community Team is led by Carol Filmanski of the United Methodist Church and Cathy Duke of Philipstown Reform Synagogue. Their team of local volunteers works closely with the family, orienting them to US customs and culture and helping them integrate into the Cold Spring community. This team also provides personal support, from babysitting during the parent's ESL classes, to accompanying them to local stores, to being a friend in time of need. We are now building a fifth Community Team to prepare for our next resettlement. My Dear Parishioners,
