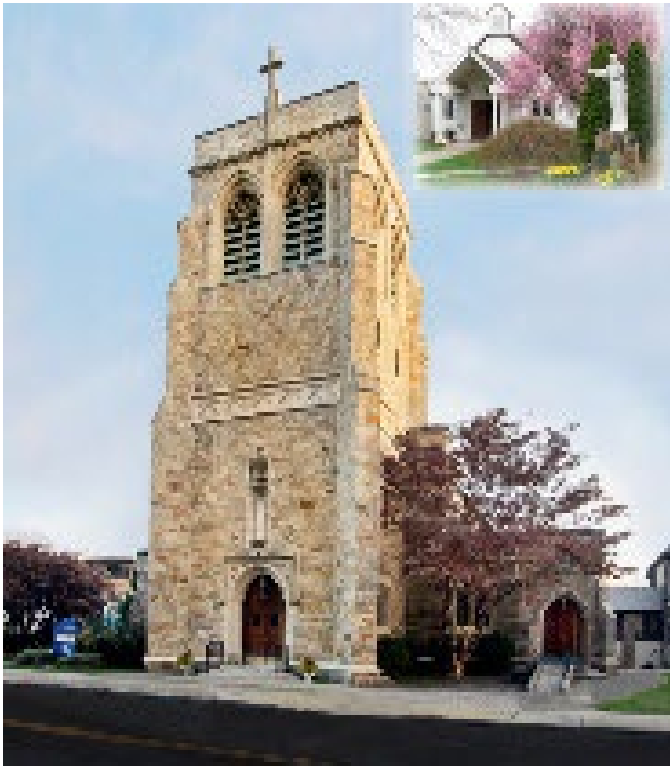

## **Open Arms for Refugees**

Community Teams: The Heart of Community

Open Arms has used the model of a dedicated local Community Team that engages regularly with the family from Day One. This team is supported by specialized Open Arms co-chairs in housing, furnishings, ESL, employment, healthcare, and personal budgeting/finance. For example, in Cold Spring the Community Team is led by Carol Filmanski of the United Methodist Church and Cathy Duke of Philipstown Reform Synagogue. Their team of local volunteers works closely with the family, orienting them to US customs and culture and helping them integrate into the Cold Spring community. This team also provides personal support, from babysitting during the parent's ESL classes, to accompanying them to local stores, to being a friend in time of need. We are now building a fifth Community Team to prepare for our next resettlement. ## *From the Pastor's Desk*

Sept. 18 2022

My Dear Parishioners,

It is the time of the year when we get set to return: the children return to school, and the younger ones are excited to get started with life. The teenagers get set for college, work, and learning to earn a livelihood; then we have the teens in religious formation preparing to leap into an adult Catholic life in their faith journey, with their preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. Please pray for these maturing Catholics who in this present climate do need all the prayers and support they can get.

We shall continue to have the daily noon Mass at the Chapel until October. During the summer we have restarted the weekly Mass for our people at Skyview and here is my appeal to you, my parishioners-- to help us at the Mass and also to our Eucharistic ministers to step in and serve those who are unable to attend the Wednesday Mass. We also stand in need of a coordinator for our youth ministry.

One sad event that came our way this summer was the passing away of our dear Pastor, Fr. Brian Brennan. His death was preceded by four years of suffering as he lay on his sick bed a victim of pancreatic cancer. I thank all those who kept praying for his recovery, especially the small group in the chapel who interceded for him all through his illness. He will be remembered for his kindness, gentleness, and compassion. But above all, he was a devoted priest who dedicated his life to the Sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist. He was a dedicated pastor who tried to bring the "lost sheep" back into the fold. He did suffer a lot, but he did it quietly and kept it to himself. With our hands joined and our eyes lifted up, we pray that eternal rest be granted him and that the perpetual light of Christ shines forever on him.
