



~ LITURGICAL MUSIC NOTES: SYMBOLS OF THE SEASON ~

A new Liturgical Year has begun, rich in symbols: royal purple, circle of candles, prophetic words echoed in hymns - inviting us into this season of expectation called Advent (Latin: adventus = coming). The lighting of a wreath is rooted in the winter solstice when days in our Western hemisphere are shortest. Each Sunday, the ring of light increases heralding the coming of the Messiah! The O Antiphons (sung in "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" - the season's 'theme song') are based on 7 Old Testament titles for Messiah: O Emmanuel, O Wisdom, O Lord of Might, O Branch/Root of Jesse, O Key of David, O Dayspring/Daystar, O Desire of Nations. Symbols of these Antiphons grace our parish's Advent processional banners - today: the Lamp of Wisdom.
