So proclaimed John the Baptist as he prepared the world for the coming of the Messiah. We may not be preparing for Jesus Christ’s arrival in the flesh or plunging into the Jordan River, but John’s words apply just as much today as they did then. We must recognize and repent of our sins in order to be prepared for the Lord’s arrival in our lives in any way. And the kingdom of heaven is still at hand, glimpsed when we are reconciled with God and our neighbor. May we hear John’s words as if they were directed to us here and now. – *Pastoral Patterns*

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

THE KINGDOM OF GOD

In the story of creation, God created animals of all kinds: birds of the sky, fish in the waters, wild and tame animals on land. God looked at it all and pronounced it good. No mention is made of wild animals preying on smaller animals or any two animals attacking each other. Eden was a paradise. In order to portray the effect of a Messiah coming to Judah, Isaiah recalls the harmonious interactions of animals in Eden. This is God's plan of coexistence among the myriad species of beasts. This is God's peaceable kingdom. This is a model of the kind of kingdom Isaiah prophesies, John proclaims, and Jesus presents. *Pastoral Patterns*

SEEING JESUS IN OUR NEIGHBORS

Let us now reimagine the animals as people. We think of the different natures, behaviors, and instincts of animals, and the same can be true of people. People have many various faults, traits, habits, and personalities. How to reconcile them all in such a way that all eight billion of us can live together in peace? This continues to be a challenge, but Jesus has given us a road map. Turn the other cheek, forgive each other, love your neighbor, care for the least of your brothers and sisters. If we can see Jesus in the faces of those in need, we can see the kingdom when we serve them. *Pastoral Patterns*

HARMONY IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

The harmony among the animals portrayed by Isaiah is recalled when Paul speaks to the Romans, asking that God may "grant you to think in harmony with one another, in keeping with Christ Jesus" (Romans 15:5). Normally, it's a great challenge to think in harmony with others, even with just other members of your family. But if all are truly thinking in harmony with the Lord, agreement can be found. Importantly, it requires honesty, humility, and guidance from the Holy Spirit. May we take the time and make the effort to increase the harmony of the world. *Pastoral Patterns*

REINO DE DIOS

En la historia de la creación Dios creó animales de todo tipo: los pájaros del cielo, los peces en el mar, bestias salvajes y animales domesticables en la tierra. Dios lo vio todo y lo declaró bueno. No se menciona nada acerca de las bestias salvajes asediando a los animales más pequeños ni acerca de dos animales atacándose mutuamente. El Edén era un paraíso. Con el fin de describir el efecto de un Mesías que llega a Judá, Isaías recuerda las armoniosas interacciones de los animales en el Edén. Así es el plan de Dios sobre la existencia de la infinidad de especies de animales. Así es el Reino pacífico de Dios. Ése es un modelo del tipo de reino que Isaías profetiza, Juan proclama y Jesús presenta. Palabras Pastorales

VER A JESÚS EN NUESTRA PROJIMO

Imaginémonos ahora lo mismo, pero en vez de ser animales son personas. Consideremos que las diferentes naturalezas, y los diferentes comportamientos e instintos de los animales pueden ser igual en las personas. Las personas tienen muchas y variadas faltas y características, así como hábitos y personalidades. ¿Cómo podríamos reconciliar toda esa variedad de personas de manera que los ocho billones de nosotros podamos vivir juntos y en paz? Esto continúa siendo un reto, pero Jesús nos ha dado un mapa a seguir. Ofrezcan la otra mejilla, perdónense mutuamente, amen a su prójimo, atiendan al más pequeño entre sus hermanos y hermanas. Si pudiéramos ver a Jesús en los rostros de los necesitados, veremos el Reino cuando nos entregamos a servirles. Palabras Pastorales

ARMONÍA EN EL ESPÍRITU SANTO

La armonía entre los animales que describe Isaías la podemos recordar cuando Pablo les habla a los romanos y ruega “que Dios les conceda a ustedes vivir en perfecta armonía unos con otros, conforme al espíritu de Cristo Jesús” (romanos 15, 5). Normalmente, pensar en vivir en armonía con otros, aún con otros miembros de la propia familia, presenta un gran reto. Pero si verdaderamente todos piensan en esa armonía con el Señor, se puede llegar a un acuerdo. Es muy importante reconocer que esto requiere honestidad, humildad y la guía del Espíritu Santo. Que dediquemos el tiempo y hagamos el esfuerzo para que aumente la armonía en el mundo. a traernos la salvación, o sea, para vivir con Dios por siempre en el Reino eterno en donde todos compartimos nuestra alabanza y gloria a Dios por toda la eternidad. On December 8 we celebrate the patronal solemnity of the United States and the greatest of Mary's Advent festivals. On that day we remember Mary's conception in the womb of her mother (and nine months later, on September 8, we celebrate months later, on September 8, we celebrate Mary's birth). In this liturgy, we affirm our belief that God prepared Mary to be the mother of the son of God by allowing her a share, from the moment of her conception, in the salvation that would be won for all by Christ.

Five mothers make their presence felt on December 8. The first is Eve, the mother of all the living. The second is Mary's mother, who conceived, brought to birth, and nurtured an "immaculate" daughter who would become the mother of the Word made Flesh. The third is Elizabeth, who conceived her son John "in her old age." The fourth, of course, is Mary herself. Finally, the letter to the Ephesians and the texts of the Mass for this feast remind us that the Church has been "chosen" to be a spiritual mother. We pray: "The image of the Virgin is found in your Church . . . Trace in our actions the lines of her love, in our hearts her readiness of faith."

In this Advent time, we are called, as Mary was, to make room for Christ in our hearts. What will it take, what will be the cost for us to become, as Mary became, real "bearers of the Word?" Let us be open to the intercession of Mary on our behalf, that we may become more and more like her beloved Son.

Oh María de la Inmaculada Concepción, Madre de Cristo, tuviste influencia sobre tu Divino Hijo mientras estuvo en esta tierra; tienes la misma influencia ahora en el Cielo. Ruega por nosotros y obtén de Él el cumplimiento de mi petición si es la Divina Voluntad. Amén.

El 8 de diciembre celebramos la solemnidad patronal de los Estados Unidos y la mayor de las fiestas de Adviento de María. Ese día recordamos la concepción de María en el seno de su madre (y nueve meses después, celebramos el nacimiento de María). En esta liturgia, afirmamos nuestra creencia de que Dios preparó a María para ser la madre del hijo de Dios al permitirle participar, desde el momento de su concepción, en la salvación que sería ganada para todos por Cristo.

Cinco madres hacen sentir su presencia el 8 de diciembre. La primera es Eva, la madre de todos los vivos. La segunda es la madre de María, que concibió, dio a luz y alimentó a una hija "inmaculada" que se convertiría en la madre del Verbo hecho carne. La tercera es Isabel, que concibió a su hijo Juan "en su vejez". La cuarta, por supuesto, es la propia María. Finalmente, la carta a los Efesios y los textos de la misa de esta fiesta nos recuerdan que la Iglesia ha sido "elegida" para ser madre espiritual. Rezamos: "La imagen de la Virgen se encuentra en tu Iglesia... Traza en nuestras acciones las líneas de su amor, en nuestros corazones su disposición a la fe".

En este tiempo de Adviento, estamos llamados, como María, a dar cabida a Cristo en nuestros corazones. ¿Qué nos costará, qué nos costará convertirnos, como María, en verdaderos "portadores de la Palabra"? Estemos abiertos a la intercesión de María en nuestro favor, para que nos parezcamos cada vez más a su amado Hijo. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co., Inc.




