 Door rot to be scrapped out, wood treated with hardener, hole filled with polymer patch repaint.




Cracks in wall of chapel along southeast side (requires followup)







Remodel first floor Rectory lavatory/laundry room

 Rectory first floor lavatory is over an unheated space which has led to burst piping recently. It currently has no hot water. The section has been in need of significant plumbing work for years. All pipes including drainage are subjected to freeze/thaw. The initial plan is to add a shower room where the lavatory is and move all pipes to the main basement away from the cold and relocate the lavatory by 6 ft. Most work can be done by volunteers except for relocating one radiator. Photo below is a recent pipe burst (Jan 2022).

We added a liner to the Lewis street side Rectory fireplace in 2020 as required for a permit to make improvements in the boiler. Repaint Parish Hall Ceiling

- NOTE June 14 a small test scrape of the ceiling material near the elevator was done to see how difficult it would be to remove the ceiling covering. While the bulk of the material comes off easily, the surface does not scrape smoothly. I would expect removing the ceiling material and getting it smooth enough to paint would be a significant undertaking beyond a DYI. I believe the substrate is cellulose as that seems to be the material being used today. Another observation is that some of the material seems to be flaking off especially in the corners. We may need to look into applying a sealer to try and keep what we have intact before painting. I recommend that we get a quote from a painter who has done ceilings like this before we consider painting ourselves. At least that way we know what is involved to do a lasting job. From some of the flaking I observed, the weight of paint may cause some of the substrate to fall if not adherent. Maybe a specialized paint is required for ceilings of this type.

Improve space available for Church flower preparation

 Remove cabinets and find a place for storage to allow better head room for flower prep

Update 4-15-22 Venting behind altar under music books may be able to be converted to storage. Vents lead directly to crawl space below. Old organ blower in this space replaced with another years ago. Hughes assessment is vents not needed

Update April 27

we abandoned organ blower in the crawl space over a decade ago. A new blower was installed above the organ near the pipes. So it looks like all the vents behind the organ are not needed. I will get one final eval from Hughes when they come but it looks like we will have a significant increase in storage behind the altar. The entire width of the space can be converted to anything we want (within reason). I would like for Michael to get together with altar guild rep and flower rep and come up with a plan to present to the Buildings Commission for action. This could allow at least for some of the above sink cabinets to be remove to open up more space for flower prep

Repair broken window hinge

Update 6/16/22 – Roger meeting with Patrick Baldoni, Feminella to evaluate this window and all SG windows; expecting estimate soon

- (1) Provision of venting for all 16 SG windows, some evidence of moisture on exterior leading, recommend narrow venting screens at top and bottom of each window from the inside. NOTE: Venting from the outside through the glazing would give us heating and nose problems.
- (2) Provision of hardware to limit degree of opening small movable windows at bottom of each SG window. This is a safety measure to prevent small children from falling out.
- (3) Lubrication of latches on each window.
- (4) Replacement of two small pieces of stained glass broken by apparently excessively aggressive yanking on latches.
- (5) Some minor repair of putty.







