### Characteristics of the Spirituality of a Missionary Disciple Part I

**Certified by our Baptisms**, we are called to first an Attitude of Gratitude for the blessings God has poured out upon us. He created humanity to care for His creations. He entered into Human History and became one like us in all things but sin. He died on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins and opened the gate of heaven, He Rose from the Dead and gave us the opportunity to enjoy eternal life. He sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and gave birth to His Church. Personally, in coming to life from our Mother's womb, we have been blessed with the gifts of faith, hope and love, and special gifts and talents for our good and the good of God's people. We have been forgiven should we ever stumble or fall. He has provided us the opportunity to order our steps according to His word and be qualified to carry out one or more of the aspects of His Mission and Ministry, starting with making disciples, that is bringing others to Christ and to the Body of Christ the Church. So yes, we start each day with an attitude of gratitude, thanking God for waking us up this morning and thus, it is already a Good Day and after that it only gets better and never gets worse. It lays the foundation for developing relationships with God and the members of His Body, you and I, which is what the word Spirituality means; living in relationship with... That is fostered by daily prayer(Do you have a prime time for daily prayer?), at minimum Sunday Worship in Church so to receive the Holy Eucharist or if by "necessity" online, reading the Word of God(see invitation below and reasons why) and spending time with not only the family, but also the faith family as well. It is fostered by our participating in the Mission and Ministry of Jesus Christ(this is not volunteering, but an essential part of our Spirituality of Missionary Discipleship) and consciously and actively bringing others to Christ. We do this through example, through exposing our faith, through acting on our faith, by personally inviting others inside and outside our family to join us.

<u>I am repeating the invitation</u> to read the daily scriptures once for the heart, once for the head, and once for the Holy Spirit to move in and through us through the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website <a href="https://www.usccb.org">www.usccb.org</a>. where you can click on the "Daily Readings" where you can sign up for them to be delivered via email to your computer/cellphone every day. In addition, I am inviting anyone who wishes to join the Daily M-F Prayer Call w/Rosary and Daily Scripture Reflection at 8 AM each morning. You can use a cell phone or a land line phone to participate. You dial the Google Conference Call number 1-636-707-2582 (You can make it a contact # on your cell phone under A Rosary Call-higher up the alphabet and speed dial it). Once you arrive you at the Google site, you tap in the code which is 896-205-293 and # sign. At that point you can hear the call and stay muted so background noise at your house won't interfere with the prayer leaders. It takes about 25 minutes and with the Pastor's Reflection on the days Gospel, about 40 minutes. Maybe not good for working folks unless you are working at home, but great for the elderly, sick and shut-ins to be part of a powerhouse of prayer for the needs of our people and the church.
