Qualifications to Run

- Maintain a minimum overall grade average (C or higher; no failing grades).
- Be in good academic standing with no academic probation.
- Demonstrate positive citizenship and leadership qualities in and out of the classroom.
- No major disciplinary infractions during the current or previous semester.
- Maintain regular attendance with no unexcused absences or excessive tardiness.
- Submit at least one teacher's endorsement.
- Obtain parent/guardian approval.
- Agree to fulfill the duties of the office, attend meetings/events, and follow campaign guidelines.

Expectations of Service if Elected

- Attending meetings at lunch/recess approximately twice a month.
- Attending both the November and January Open Houses as tour guides for prospective families.
- Helping to plan activities for Catholic Schools Week.
- Identifying a realistic need within the school and fundraising for it (goal under \$500).
- Planning one or two middle school dances (winter/spring).
- Assisting with planning Field Day.
- Contributing one Knightly News article per month on Student Leadership activities.
- Organizing a service project.

Additional responsibilities may be added at the discretion of the advisor and administration as new opportunities for leadership arise.
