

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My dear friends,

As we prepare for the summer months of July and August and look forward to the Fall, I hope this printed bulletin will allow the opportunity to reflect on where we are as a parish and how we envision this September and beyond.

While there is always a good deal to be maintained in parish and family life, Pope Francis is always reminding us to be a Church on Mission. Our share in fostering that Mission of Jesus Christ's Grace and Salvation is founded on the fact that by Baptism we are beloved daughters and sons of God in Jesus Christ. This identity then gives us the ability to enter into relationship with the Father, the Son Jesus and the Holy Spirit through the daily union of prayer and the weekly Holy Communion of the Eucharist. Flowing from this identity and relationship is finally where we receive our mission - the particular good that God is asking of me this moment, this day, this week, this year and even this life as my vocation.

Saint Mother Teresa would formulate this dynamic differently: "The fruit of silence is prayer; the fruit of prayer is faith; the fruit of faith is love; the fruit of love is service; the fruit of service is peace." With the reopening of our Perpetual Adoration Chapel this September, I hope and pray it may be a good source of prayer, faith and inspiration for all sorts of charity.

This past season, our Parish Council under the leadership of Eileen Tobin, President, has been hard at work with various committees, particularly the Social Ministries Outreach Committee. Based on their thorough work with what Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish is doing and has been involved in, I offer this reflection as an opportunity to invite new or deeper ways of service as the good Lord may be inspiring us in our hearts.

When people ask from time-to-time, what can I do to help, what comes to my mind are the Church's Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. They are the organic and ordinary way of God's grace transforming the world one person encountering another at a time. Their foundation is from Matthew's Gospel, chapter 25 verses 31 to 46, where Jesus' radically identifies himself with the least among us and lets us know what will separate the sheep from the goats on the Last Day when we stand before Him in Judgment

So if we never had an opportunity to commit them to memory or have not considered them previously, here we go:

# The Corporal Works of Mercy:

To feed the hungry.
To give water to the thirsty.
To clothe the naked.
To shelter the homeless.
To visit the sick.
To visit the imprisoned, or ransom the captive.
To bury the dead.

# The Spiritual Works of Mercy:

To instruct the ignorant.
To counsel the doubtful.
To admonish the sinner.
To bear wrongs patiently.
To forgive offenses willingly.
To comfort the afflicted.
To pray for the living and the dead.

As we reflect on these time-tested opportunities to put our faith into action (as we see from the Letter of James 2:14-26), it is always good to start in our homes, our places of work, our schools and in our neighborhoods. Even still, perhaps the Lord is moving your heart to get more involved in a particular way with one of the ministries that IHM does or even to develop a response to an unmet local or more broad need. It may inspire a form of public service in some, but a service that does not seek to hide our beliefs from the world, rather one that seeks to live out being Members of Christ's Body the Church in such service.

When it comes to the Spiritual Works of Mercy, perhaps there is an ignorance of some part of the faith or of Scripture in us. Perhaps the Lord may be inviting us to deeper knowledge of the faith so that our love of Jesus and His brothers and sisters may deepen. We are blessed with wonderful online materials through Flocknotes from Formed (Saint Augustine Institute) and Engage (Word on Fire - Bishop Barron). I expect that the parish will also offer other in-person formation opportunities in the Fall, such as our Women's Formation Group had this past Spring. Such formation may set our hearts on fire with lesus and make us more authentic witnesses seeking to bring the Light of Christ to others in charity. Perhaps it may lead some to become catechists in our Religious Education Program or others to join the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults to become a fully initiated Catholic.

This summer, as you reconnect with family, get away for relaxation and seek good recreation, please do not forget that our souls need a summer break, too. Consider an opportunity for refreshment and renewal in quiet and especially in the presence of our Lord. Who knows what Jesus may stir up in the depths of our hearts, opening our eyes to needs close to us or further away. It is a good opportunity to review our service of time, talent or treasure that enables us to take our part in the Mission of Jesus Christ for the Salvation of the World.


# FROM THE DESK OF PRINCIPAL TRACY KEELIN

# **RENEW + REBUILD UPDATE**

Goal: \$1,774,500 **Pledged:** \$2,372,813 Paid: \$1,998,473 **Balance:** \$374,399



Implementing phase one of the Renew + Rebuild repairs is underway. It addresses church and rectory roof repairs, window repairs and replacement, exterior masonry repairs as well as the complete replacement of the lower church windows.

The Architect's project drawings were submitted for bid and the contractor has been selected. All required documentation and information have been submitted to the NY Archdiocese for review and approval at Easter. What previously had taken a month for approval, is now taking up to six months.

The Contractor will mobilize as soon as the NY Archdiocese approval is granted, and a schedule will be issued.

The R + R Committee is currently looking ahead to the planning and funding of Phase 2 which will include painting and flooring of the church interi-
