**CHAPTER 2**

<sup>1</sup>When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod,<sup>4</sup> behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup>saying, “Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star<sup>5</sup> at its rising and have come to do him homage.”<sup>6</sup> <sup>3</sup>When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. <sup>4</sup>Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. <sup>7</sup><sup>5</sup><sup>8</sup>They said to him, “In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:
