



Did you know...

There are four Dogmas of the Church that relate to Our Blessed Mother? The first Marian dogma is the Divine Motherhood of God. The second is that Mary remained a virgin throughout her entire life. Third, the Dogma of the Immaculate Conception that she was conceived without original sin and fourth, The Assumption of Mary into heaven.

What's a Dogma? Dogma is another name for what the Church officially believes to be true. A truth revealed by God and the Church declared it infallibly.



BUILDING OUR CHURCH




