

Did you know...

That the outer vestment a priest wears is called a chasuble and the outer vestment a deacon wears is called a dalmatic. They usually look similar but not exactly. One way to tell the difference is that the chasuble covers the priest's arms but has not sleeves.

The dalmatic has long wide-sleeves.






Consider GIVING ONLINE




