Sabías...

WELCOME TO THE DEACON'S CORNER...



The Incarnation tells us the most important truth about ourselves: we are destined for a divine character. The Church Fathers never tired of repeating the phrase: God became human so that humans might become God. God entered into flesh so that our flesh might partake of the divine life, that we might participate in the love that holds the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in communion. How great is God's love that the Word became flesh. -Deacon Randy

Did you know...

The Priest kissing the altar at the beginning and ending of Mass is a reverent way to honor the special role it has in the liturgy and the consecration to God it was given by the bishop. Symbolically the altar is often said to represent Jesus Christ, the “cornerstone” of the Church (cf. Ephesians 2:20). The priest would sometimes kiss the altar before blessing the people, symbolizing how the blessing came from God, not the priest.



BUILDING OUR CHURCH

We have received permission to engage an architect for conceptual design and estimate for our permanent church building in parallel to conducting a feasibility study to better determine how much we can afford. The Building Team has been commissioned to begin the work of architect selection.

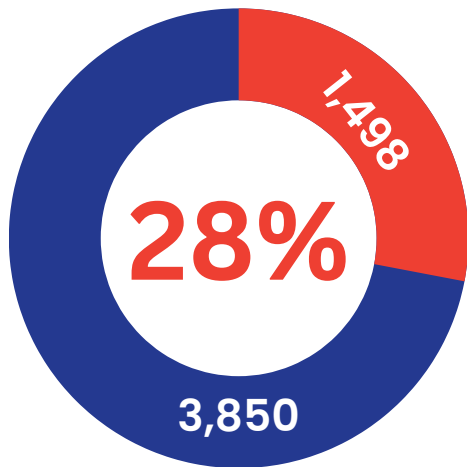

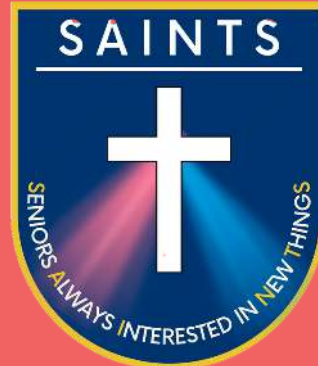
