THEOLOGICAL VIRTUES

SUPERNATURAL GIFTS INFUSED BY GOD AT BAPTISM WHICH DIRECTLY RELATE TO HIM AND DISPOSE ONE TO LIVE IN RELATIONSHIP WITH THE FATHER, THE SON, AND THE HOLY SPIRIT

FAITH

Enables one to know God and all that He has revealed.

HOPE

Enables one to desire God above all things and to trust Him for our salvation.

CHARITY

Enables one to love God above all and to love our neighbor as ourselves.

CARDINAL VIRTUES

PIVOTAL HABITS OF RIGHT THINKING, ORDERING OF THE PASSIONS, AND MORAL CONDUCT WHICH AIM TO PERFECT HUMAN LIVING

PRUDENCE

(Sound Judgment)

Enables one to reason and to act rightly in any given situation — "right reason in action."

JUSTICE

(Fairness)

Enables one to give to each, beginning with God, what is due him.

FORTITUDE

(Courage)

Enables one to endure difficulties and pain for the sake of what is good.

TEMPERANCE

(Self-control)

Enables one to be moderate in the pleasure and use of created goods.

GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

INFUSED BY GOD AT BAPTISM, THE GIFTS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE VIRTUES, MAKE ONE RECEPTIVE TO THE INSPIRATIONS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (SEE ISAIAH 1:1-2)

UNDERSTANDING

- Enables one to see more deeply into the mysteries of the faith and judge with certainty all created things.
- Perfects the theological virtue of Faith

FEAR OF THE LORD

- Brings forth the fear of offending God by sin.
- Perfects the theological virtue of Hope and the cardinal virtue of Temperance

PIETY

- Inclines one as a child of God to have devotion and honor to God as Father.
- Perfects the cardinal virtue of Justice

KNOWLEDGE

- Guides one in knowing what to believe and how to share it with others.
- Perfects the theological virtue of Faith

COUNSEL

- Enables one to respond fully to the direction and guidance from the Lord.
- Perfects the cardinal virtue of Prudence

FORTITUDE

- Moves one to endure difficulties for the sake of eternal life with God.
- Perfects the cardinal virtue of Fortitude

WISDOM

- Moves one to order one's life according to God's will.
- Perfects the theological virtue of Charity
