

Be sure to log-in and complete this year's Safe Environment training – all online, and available in both English and Spanish! Staff and volunteers - we'd like you all to be Safe Environment cleared. Follow these steps to complete your training now:

- 1. Go to dallas.setanet.org. At the top of the page in small type, click on "My Obligations."
- 2. On the My Obligations page, enter your first name, last name, and street address. Please be sure to use your legal name as it is listed in the Diocesan Safe Environment database. BEFORE YOU CREATE A NEW RECORD, try entering your old address if you have problems finding yourself.
- 3. Click on "search" to find your information as it currently appears in the database. Update and verify your personal information, then click on "update information and continue" at the bottom.
- You are now on the Welcome page. Under "Classes available to take online," click on the appropriate language for the "Sexual Abuse Awareness Training." There are videos and a 25-question test at the end. You must score at least 70% to be given credit for the test.
