Back in the day and still in some parishes and dioceses, notices were placed in parish bulletins about upcoming nuptial ceremonies in the local Church. These canonical notices, called "banns," were invitations to members of the faith community to come forward with any concerns about the seriousness and ability of the named couple to enter into the sacrament of Matrimony. It was a form of "if anyone has anything against this marriage, let them speak now or forever hold their peace." Nowadays this canonical vetting is done through signed affidavits that each engaged person secures from people who know them well. But in the spirit of the former practice of banns, below is a list of couples currently preparing for marriage through the auspices of St. Ann's to marry here at our church or elsewhere in a Catholic space more suited to their circumstances. Many of them are being blessed at this weekend's Masses with the Church's beautiful <u>Blessing of Engaged Couples</u>.
