Xavier High School is a co-ed Jesuit Catholic school founded in 1952 to support a sense of Micronesian unity and identity. We serve over 120 students from across the Micronesia region.

Students receive financial aid to attend. Instruction is in English, which is a second language for many of our students.

We are recruiting teacher volunteers for Spring 2023 and future school years! Our teachers offer 3 to 5 classes, coach extracurricular clubs and sports, and participate in the life of the school (meals, Mass, retreats, local community events).

Teacher volunteers receive free housing and all meals, a monthly stipend for personal expenses, and round-trip transportation to/from the school. The nearby Chuuk Lagoon is famed for its snorkeling and scuba diving!
