


Fascinating Strawberry Facts

- Eight strawberries provide only 45 calories, 140 percent of the RDA for vitamin C and three grams of fiber.

- Strawberries are the only fruit with seeds found on the outside instead of the inside.
- The only way to harvest strawberries is by hand.
- The largest strawberry ever picked was half a pound.
- Historically, strawberries represent peace and prosperity.
- The average American eats 4.85 pounds of strawberries annually.
- Strawberries offer the most flavor when eaten at room temperature.
- Strawberries are a member of the rose family.
- Birds are responsible for the spread of strawberry seeds across the country.
- Belgium offers a museum dedicated entirely to strawberries.


