Visit your doctor on a regular basis. Monitor your blood pressure and cholesterol levels.

Maintain a healthy weight.
Keep your body mass index
(BMI) level under 25. BMI levels
above 25 are associated with an
increased risk of developing
heart disease. Your BMI level is
determined by using a formula
that includes a person's weight
and height.

Here is a list of heart-healthy foods: salmon, oatmeal, tuna, carrots, spinach, broccoli, sweet potatoes, asparagus, oranges, tomatoes, cantaloupe, and tea. All of these foods can be found on the menu at American House.
