



CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR NEW KITTEN!



The Doctors and Staff at Flying Cloud Animal Hospital have prepared the following checklist to help keep track of your kitten's health requirements for the first few months. Please bring this list along when you bring your kitten in for visits.

8 Weeks Old

- 1st Feline Distemper vaccination- series of 3 boosters
(Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis (herpesvirus), Calicivirus, Panleukopenia and Chlamydia Psittaci)
- Fecal Examination (Intestinal parasite screening- about 1 tsp fresh sample is needed)
- Veterinarian application of Revolution© (Applied monthly, this topical helps protect against intestinal parasites, fleas, ticks, ear mites and feline heartworm)

12 Weeks Old

- 2nd Feline Distemper booster
 - Feline Leukemia Virus test (Must test negative in order to vaccinate)
 - 1st Feline Leukemia Virus vaccination
 - Fecal Examination (if not already completed)
 - Veterinarian application of Revolution©
 - Pre-Surgical bloodwork (Discuss options with your veterinarian or veterinary technician)
- *Can be declawed at this age

16 Weeks Old

- 3rd Feline Distemper booster
- 2nd Feline Leukemia Virus booster
- Initial Rabies vaccination
- 1st FIP vaccination (Feline Infectious Peritonitis- Optional vaccine, discuss with your veterinarian)
- Fecal Examination (if not already completed)
- Monthly application of Revolution©

5 – 6 Months Old

- 2nd FIP booster (if applicable)
 - Pre-Surgical bloodwork (Discuss options with your veterinarian or veterinary technician)
 - Monthly application of Revolution©
- *Spay/neuter can be done at this age (Declaw can be combined with this procedure)

1 Year from last set of vaccines

- Feline Distemper vaccine
- Rabies vaccine
- Feline Leukemia Virus vaccine
- FIP vaccine (if applicable)
- Fecal Examination
- Continue monthly application of Revolution©
