Boarding Release Form

Thank you for selecting Animal Health Center for your boarding needs. We will do our very best to make your pets stay with us a happy and comfortable experience. We will take care of your pet and their needs as if they were our own.

Even with the best care, boarding can be stressful because your pet is in a new environment, away from home. Pet's routines and habits are interrupted. Common problems encountered while boarding include: decreased appetite, constipation, weight loss, and stress diarrhea. If problems develop and are persistent, our kennel assistants may ask for a doctor to examine your pet at the cost of a boarding exam. If the doctor feels that treatment is necessary, you will be contacted by phone and any additional treatments will first be authorized. If we are unable to contact you and the doctor feels there are serious problems, your pet will be treated and normal fees will be charged. It is very important that you leave a contact number so we can reach you in an emergency or to pre-approve and potential treatments.

Boarding Policies:

1. There is a daily charge for medications given. Please advise us of any special treatments or medications needed while boarding. Leaving written instructions helps us give the best possible care. Please bring with you any medication needed by your pet.
2. All animals are required to be up to date on ALL VACCINES. Any vaccines that are needed must be given upon entrance. Vaccines must be administered by a licensed veterinarian. Proof of current vaccinations must be submitted to the hospital BEFORE any animal will be admitted for boarding.
 - Canine patients: DA2PPV within the last 3 years
 Rabies within the last 3 years
 Bordetella within the last 6 months
 - Feline patients: FVRCP within the last 3 years
 Rabies within the last 3 years
3. All animals must be free of external parasites (fleas & ticks) when admitted for boarding or must be treated upon admission at owner's expense.
4. Checkout/Check in is only during regular business hours.
5. Science Diet Foods (adult, puppy, and kitten) are provided at no extra charge, or you may bring your pet's own food from home. We will prepare up to three meals a day for our boarding guests at no additional charge.
6. Personal belongings such as a towel, blanket, may be brought along with your pet's own food and treats. We make every effort to keep belongings clean, however, we are not responsible for any damages to belongings that may occur. The boarding facility provides pets with bedding at no additional charge.
7. Collars, leashes, and toys are not allowed in the boarding facility as they may cause a choking hazard to pets. Collars have been known to get caught on cages and toys may be chewed into small pieces and swallowed by your pet.
