## SURGERY/ANESTHESIA AUTHORIZATION

Your pet is being admitted for the above anesthetic procedure. Please be assured that the veterinarian(s) and staff of Eagle Animal Clinic will use the safest anesthetics available and that your pet will be constantly monitored throughout the procedure. Regardless of an animal's age or apparent health status, understand that all anesthetic procedures have an element of risk including, but not limited to stroke, deafness, or death.

Should unexpected life-saving emergency care be required for my pet, and the hospital staff is unable to reach me, the doctor's and/or staff has my permission to provide any and all necessary treatments.

Eagle Animal Clinic will be performing a pre-anesthetic blood test prior to, or on the day of, the surgery or procedure to minimize the anesthetic risk for your pet. These tests allow us to check on organ functions of the liver, pancreas, kidneys, and blood. We will also be placing a catheter in your pet's leg to administer intravenous fluids during his or her anesthetic procedure. These tests and procedures will enable us to take the appropriate steps to reduce the risks from otherwise undetected problems.

### Complete Blood Panel

For older pets and/or those with pre-existing medical conditions, it is recommended to perform more complete and comprehensive blood testing. There is an additional fee of **\$40.00** to run the additional serum chemistries.

### Microchip Implantation

When your pet is under anesthesia, we can implant a small chip under your pet's skin for permanent identification. The cost for the implantation procedure, the microchip, and the registration fee is **\$63.00**.

### Screening for Hip Dysplasia

Hip dysplasia affects all sizes and breeds of dogs and can lead to severe and crippling arthritis. Early diagnosis using the PennHIP method allows us to implement a medical plan that will slow the progression of the disease. Since an animal must be anesthetized to obtain the proper radiographs, now is an ideal time to perform the screening procedure.

There is an additional fee of **\$285.00** which includes the 3 necessary x-rays and the PennHIP certification fee.
