Directions from Boston and points North

- Take I-93 South
- Take Exit 7 toward Cape Cod
- Merge onto MA-3 South and continue on MA-3 South/US-44 East
- Continue onto US-6 East
- Take Exit 7 to Willow Street toward West Yarmouth
- Turn left onto Willow Street and turn slight left onto Camp Street
- Turn left on Buck Island Road and Maplewood at Mayflower Place will be on the right

Directions from points South

- Take I-95 North toward Providence
- Take I-195 East/US 6 toward E. Providence/Cape Cod
- Take Exit 22A to merge onto MA-25 E
- Take Exit 3 to merge onto US-6 East toward Bourne/Hyannis
- Enter next roundabout and exit onto MA-6A
- Merge onto US-6 E/Mid Cape Hwy
- Take Exit 7 to Willow Street toward West Yarmouth
- Turn left onto Willow Street and turn slight left onto Camp Street
- Turn left on Buck Island Road and Maplewood at Mayflower Place will be on the right






