the dining room. These are just a few of the family members that help make Garden Square better, thank you all so much!

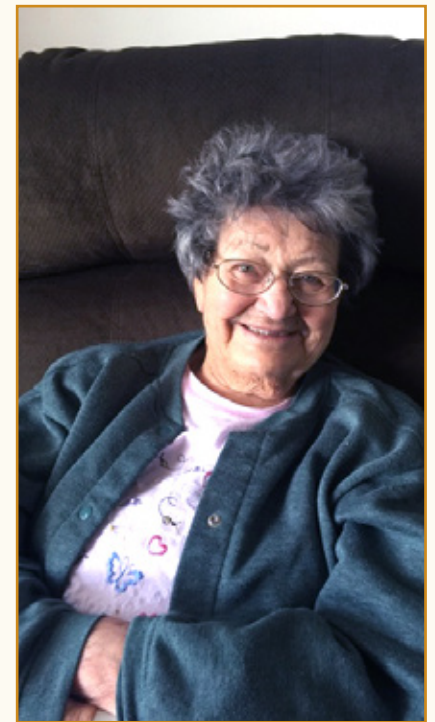
Some of you may have heard, but I will be leaving Garden Square for six weeks starting in June.

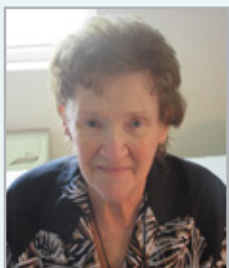

Here is what the staff had to say about Donna Sue:

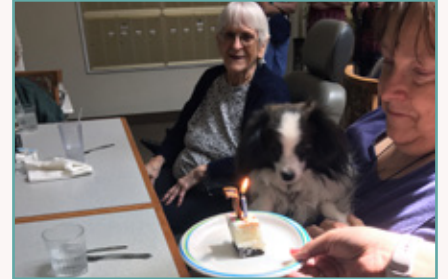
- *Donna Sue is always friendly and polite.*
