Events in 1917

Welcome to Olive Hill, Kentucky the birthplace of Pansy Greer often referred to as a small country village offering many small stores, blacksmith shop and Scott

Tavern. The small residential area was quaint attracting middle-class, working families. According to historical notes, the first contract to carry mail was led by Zachary Tyree making two trips a week by horseback from Olive Hill to Portsmouth. Mr. Tyree soon opened the first store in Olive Hill and the second store was started by William C. Greer. **Any connections here?** Of course, that's not all! The Kentucky Historical Marker No. 640 is located at US 60 at Olive Hill, KY which is the location of the home of former Congressman and Governor William Jason "Honest Bill" Fields. "He ran for congress from Ky.'s 9th District in 1910 and was elected seven consecutive times. In 1923, he was nominated for Governor and won." He was a Member of Congress, 1911-1923; Governor of Kentucky, 1923-27; Commonwealth Attorney, 1932-33. Buried in Olive Hill.
