Celebrate Mothers

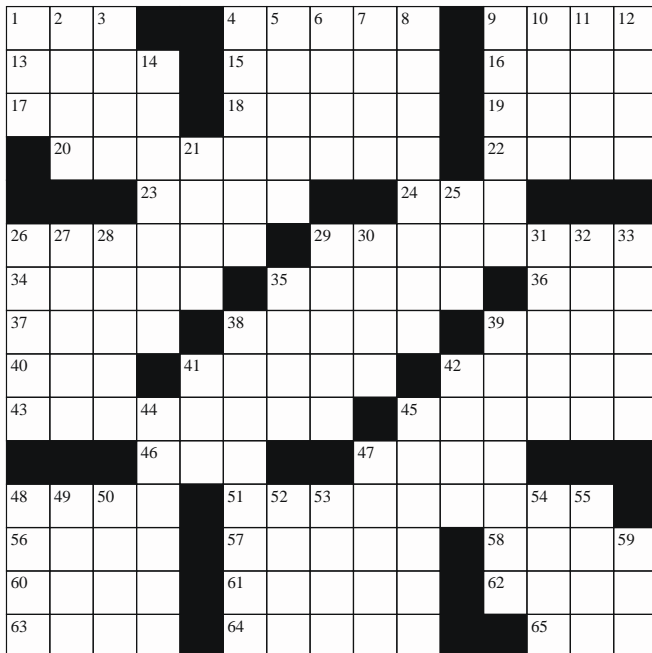
